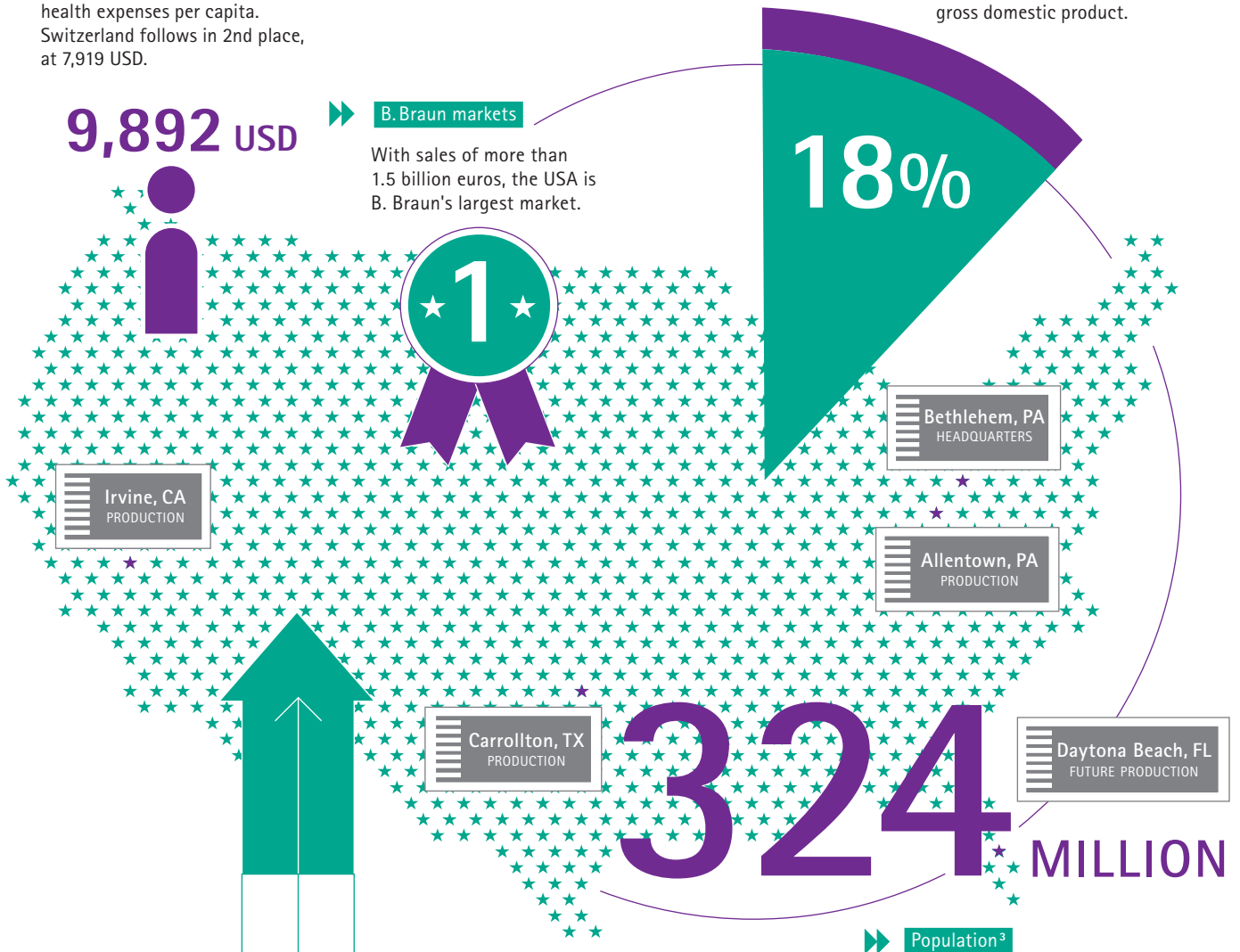
With sales of more than 1.5 billion euros, the USA is B. Braun's largest market.
